# SLO JAZZ FESTIVAL RETURNS WITH GRAMMY AWARD WINNING REBIRTH BRASS BAND, PETE ESCOVEDO LATIN JAZZ ORCHESTRA, AIRTO MOREIRA & EYEDENTITY FEATURING DIANA PURIM PLUS MORE PERFORMANCES AND CLINICS

SAN LUIS OBISPO- SLO Jazz Festival returns this year with a powerhouse line up of jazz musicians on Saturday, May 14, 2016, live at Mission Plaza in San Luis Obispo, beginning at 11:00 a.m. and concluding at 10:00 p.m. The City of San Luis Obispo returning as the title sponsor. The Festival's headliners include the Grammy Award winning Rebirth Brass Band out of New Orleans, LA. Co-headlining is Pete Escovedo Latin Jazz Orchestra, an 11-piece Latin-jazz ensemble of heavyweights joined by Jorge Burmudez, the former conga/bongo percussionist for Carlos Santana and Malo. Adding excitement to the lineup this year is legendary Airto Moreira and Eyedentity featuring Diana Purim. Joining the stellar Mission Stage lineup are John Worley and the Mo Chi Sextet performing the music from Miles Davis' Kind of Blue, which is the best-selling jazz album of all-time. Local favorites Cuesta Faculty All-Stars will open the Mission Stage. Completing the lineup on the Broad Street stage are Zzah!, a newcomer to the jazz festival but not to the Central Coast music scene; local favorite Tipsy Gypsies, showcasing music from the 1910's to present day jazz; and the Zongo All-Stars, with their unique style of high-energy "Cali-Cubano" dance music.

We are returning the Youth in Music stage, with three combos who have emerged from Cuesta College which include The Cool Notes, Toy Boat, and Umlaut; plus, the Invitational High School Honor Jazz Band and the Summer Jazz Workshop band, comprised of musicians from our Summer Jazz Workshop; and also adding a High School Band Stage at the Children's Museum this year featuring bands from Nipomo, Atascadero, and possibly one or two more area high school bands.

We're expanding our clinics this year, with a trumpet clinic by John Worley in the Museum of Art in the afternoon, and a very special percussion clinic featuring Pete Escovedo and his sons on May 13 at 6:00PM at the Museum of Art in San Luis Obispo (special ticket available).




