# SLO JAZZ FESTIVAL announces 5<sup>th</sup> Annual SLO Jazz Festival WITH 3x GRAMMY AWARD WINNING **SERGIO MENDES**

**SAN LUIS OBISPO-** The 5<sup>th</sup> Annual SLO Jazz Festival returns this year with a powerhouse line up of Latin-jazz, New Orleans' driven jazz, funk, and other jazz music on Friday, May 18, 2018 and Saturday, May 19, 2018, live at Mission Plaza in San Luis Obispo, beginning at 5:00 p.m. and ending at 10:00 p.m. Friday then beginning at 11:00 a.m. and concluding at 10:00 p.m. on Saturday night.

The Festival's headliners include Academy Award nominated and 3x Grammy Award winning SERGIO MENDES, a living legend of Brazilian and pop music, who will bring his entertaining show which includes famous hit MAS QUE NADA (featured in the movie Be Cool with the Black Eyed Peas and John Travolta). Additional Grammy winning performers PACIFIC MAMBO ORCHESTRA from San Francisco and 2018 Grammy Award Winner JEFF LORBER FUSION perform on the first ever opening night May 18, 2019.

Adding salsa excitement to the lineup this year is Afro-Cuban Ricardo Lemvo and Makina Loca. Joining the stellar International Mission Stage lineup are Anton Schwartz Quintet (straight ahead sax man) and trioKAIT, who will take you on a jazz-inspired journey through music. This year's jazz festival offers several new twists and surprises that emerge from both the spirit and vigor of San Luis Obispo and New Orleans, the birthplace of jazz. A new Broad Street "NOLA" stage includes the Pub Crawlers from Sacramento, Ragbone Saints, and local band Judith and the Jazz Krew in a New Orleans' themed new stage of regional and local all-star talent. On the Main Stage and just prior to Sergio Mendes, BIG SAM'S FUNKY NATION arrives from New Orleans, Louisiana to perform an electrifying and dance set of NOLADELIC funk.

We are adding a new "Jazz Lives" stage, which will feature Joe Duran Band's contemporary original jazz, George Garcia, Darrell Voss, and Ken Hustad "Jazz Men" as well as a repeat performance by Anton Schwartz Quintet (from Seattle, WA) headlining.

The popular Youth in Music stages return with multiple combos from Cuesta College plus the Invitational High School Honor Jazz Band and the Summer Jazz Workshop band, comprised of musicians from our Summer Jazz Workshop. The High School Band Stage at the Children's Museum also returns this year with local area high school bands. A sax clinic by Anton Schwartz will also occur in the Museum of Art in the afternoon.

The jazz festival continues to be a 98% zero-waste event and is driven by solar power.
